- The Carroll W. Monger scholarship considers financial need, academic record, character and civic participation. Priority is given to applicants who pursue careers in education, social or health services.
- The Shirley Barco Math/Science scholarship considers academic record, character and civic participation. Priority is given to applicants pursuing a career in math or science.

A scholarship in the amount of \$250.00 will be awarded to a senior graduating from one of our eleven Virginia Beach high schools. If no qualifying applications are received, the scholarship amount reverts back to the general scholarship fund.

SELECTION GUIDELINES

The recipient will be chosen after careful consideration of academic record, *character and civic participation*. Financial need will not be a considering factor for this scholarship. This scholarship does not restrict its potential recipient to any specific college, however, in keeping with the Linkhorn Park Elementary School's commitment the Math/Science Academy, the scholarship committee notes that priority in granting this award will be given to applicants who will be pursuing a career in the field of Mathematics or Science.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior in good standing at a Virginia Beach high school.
2. Applicant must have been enrolled in the Virginia Beach school system for a minimum of two years prior to applying for this scholarship, and must have attended Linkhorn Park Elementary School for a minimum of three years.
3. Applicant must have maintained an overall high school academic average of 2.5 or better.
4. By the fall of 2018, each recipient must enter an accredited college or university as a full-time student.
5. Applicant must complete the activities information form or a one page document of your choice. (School activity records count as page 2)
6. Applicant must write a short essay on their educational and career goals. (page 3)
7. Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation with their application. (pages 4 and 5)
8. Each application must include an official copy of the applicant's educational transcript. (page 6)
9. The additional information form is to be used for any supplementary information concerning financial or personal circumstances and/or school activities which the applicant wishes to disclose. (page 7)
10. Applications should be legible, one-sided only, and limited to the seven pages as directed above.
11. The amount of the scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient's college or university. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to notify the Council treasurer the college and address where payments should be made.
12. The completed application must be received by the scholarship committee chairman no later than 3 PM on FRIDAY MARCH 30, 2018.
